



Women's Studies Research Cell Rangia College

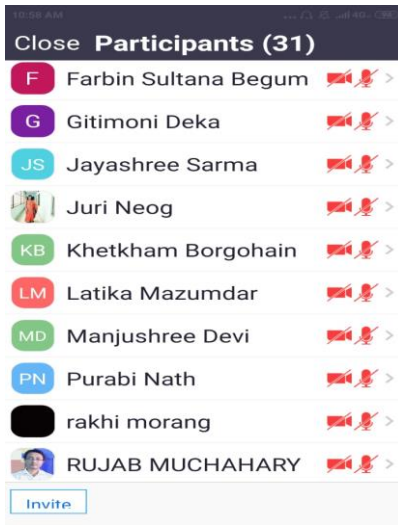
